

- To generate knowledge and insights in support of EU policy-making & strengthen the role of the EU within Europe and the world
- To <u>reach out to a wider public</u> (beyond academia and specialized audiences) ⇒ bringing EU knowledge closer to society
- To <u>function as vector for public diplomacy towards partner/third countries</u> ⇒ promoting EU values and enhancing the visibility of what the EU stands for and what it wants to achieve.

Modules are short teaching programmes or courses in the field of European Union studies at offered at a higher education institution. Concentrate on one particular discipline in European studies or be multidisciplinary in approach and therefore call upon the academic input of several professors and experts.

### Centres of Excellence: Customised lump sums

#### **CORE RULES**

- Amount of single lump sum contribution determined for each grant ⇒ based on the estimated budget proposed by applicant
- Granting authority will fix lump sum per grant ⇒ based on proposal, evaluation result, funding rates and maximum grant amount set in Call.

#### **DETAILS**

- Budget presented as detailed & coherent work packages
- Activities for each work package must be outlined in detail
- Applicants must provide breakdown of estimated costs showing the share per work package
- Typology of costs: staff, travel and subsistence, equipment, subcontracting, other.








#### Award Criteria – Jean Monnet activities in Higher education

- Slight differences between Modules, Chairs, Centres of Excellence
- To be considered for funding, proposals must score at least 70/100 points in total and 15/25 points in each award criterion
- Relevance of the project (maximum 25/100 points)
- Quality of the project design and implementation (maximum 25/100 points)
- Quality of the partnership and cooperation arrangements (maximum 25/100 points)
- Impact, dissemination and sustainability (maximum 25/100 points)






#### • Relevance of the project:

- Meet objectives of the Jean Monnet action
- fosters dialogue between the academic world and society, including local and state level policy-makers, civil servants, civil society actors, representatives of the different levels of education and of the media;
- generates knowledge and insights that can support EU policy-making and strengthen the role of the EU in a globalized world;
- includes active outreach and educational work that will spread knowledge about EU subjects to wider society (beyond academia and specialised audiences) and will bring the EU closer to the public.
- The extent the proposal reaches priority target groups
  - **Higher education students of European Union Studies**
  - Higher education students who do not automatically come into contact with EU studies
  - For Erasmus+ Partner countries, the potential to enhance EU-public diplomacy





### Quality of the project design and implementation






### Quality of the partnership and cooperation arrangements

- Excellent profile and expertise of Chair holder in European Union studies
- **Profile and expertise** of **Chair holder** and **key staff involved** in the activities proposed in the project both in terms of European Union Studies and in terms of the specific themes addressed by the proposal
- Evidence of the level of experience in research in EU subjects





#### Impact, dissemination and sustainability

- The expected impact of the project by having long lasting effects
- Dissemination and communication: disseminating the outcomes of the activities within and outside the institution hosting the Jean Monnet Action
- Raising awareness of projects and results, enhancing visibility of participants and organizations
- Reaching out to groups outside the higher education institutions
- Transferability and translation into **new policies and improved practices**
- The extent to which the dissemination tools foreseen will reach the target audience via: media exposure (including social media, publications, etc.) events


