

Editing paper guidelines

1. Format of the paper: Word A4 file.doc or .docx, margins: top, bottom, left, right - 2 , 5 cm.
2. Text of the paper: Times New Roman, 12 pt, normal, justified alignment, 1,5 spacing between lines.
3. Structure of the paper: title, information about the author / authors, abstract, keywords (4-6), extended content of the paper, bibliographical references.
 - **The title of the article** [Times New Roman, 14 pt, bold, centered, CAPS] will reflect a direct correlation with the content of the paper.
 - Information about the **author / authors:** name, surname, scientific title of author (s) below the title to one line [Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, centered], affiliation with educational institution, organization, other entity below the name to one line [Times New Roman, 12 pt, normal, centered], e-mail of the author / authors below the institution to one line [Times New Roman, 12 pt, italic, centered].
 - **Abstract** [Times New Roman, 10 pt, italics, justified alignment to 1,0 spacing between lines] will contain 150-200 words (in Romanian and English or Russian and English).
 - **Keywords:** 3-5 words [Times New Roman, 10 pt, italics, justified alignment to 1,0 spacing between lines] (in Romanian and English or Russian and English).
 - Main elements of the scientific article: **Introduction, Methods, Results and discussions, Conclusions,** [Times New Roman, 12 pt, normal, justified alignment, to 1,5 spacing between lines].
 - **The Bibliographic References** section [Times New Roman, 12 pt, normal, justified alignment, to 1,0 spacing between lines] will contain the list of references presented in alphabetical order in number of 10-15 sources. References will be written in the APA style.
For example:
Book reference format: Author, A. A., Author, B. B., Author C. C., etc. (Year of publication). Book Title: Subtitle (Edition). Place of publication: Publisher.
Journal article reference format: Author, A. A., Author, B. B., Author, C. C., etc. (Year of publication). Article title. Journal Title, Volume (Number), Pages.
Article reference format from collections: Author, A. A., Author, B. B., Author, C. C., etc. (Year of publication). Article title. Conference title: Subtitle. Place of publication: Publisher, Pages.
4. Citing authors must be done by compulsory reference of the source [1, p. 23].
5. Each article will receive DOI code.
